- Constitution
 - Article III: YDSG Representatives and Eligibility
 - Why is there specific clarification of what exactly it means to be "in good academic standing"?
- Bylaws
 - Article I: Membership
 - What is the rationale designating a senate seat as (1) MDIV/STM or (2) MAR?
 - Proposal 1: Pairing up senate seats: (1) MDIV or (2) STM / MAR
 - Rationale: Lumping ministerial degree and the academic degree
 - Potentially attaching the STM to either senate seat in the event that there isn't an interested party.
