Please include (1) an electronic copy of the manuscript (double-spaced); (2) your current address, telephone number, email address, and CV; and (3) a 100-word abstract. Submissions should be emailed to yjhple.submissions@yale.edu. Details about our editorial style are available on our website.

PEER REVIEW: Articles submitted to the *Journal* are peer reviewed. For a detailed description of the process, please visit our website.

SUBSCRIPTIONS: The *Journal* is published biannually. Subscriptions are \$29 per year for individuals and \$39 for institutions. Institutional rates apply to libraries, law firms, institutions, and individuals whose employer pays for subscriptions. Please add \$10 for overseas mailing.
